



- What is the character feeling in the book? How does the author do a good or a poor job of showing those feelings?
- What is the conflict in the novel (Character vs. character, vs. nature, vs. him/herself, vs. society)? How does it get resolved?
- What is the climax in the novel? How does the main character react?
